



Emergency Alerts

The 2010 summer news letter included the following information. The system was tested with our latest boil alert. We were pleased with how the system worked and feel it is important to publish the information again.

Clark County has instituted the WARN Wide Area Rapid Notification System—an Ultra high speed telephone communication service for emergency notifications. The system allows us to telephone all, or only targeted areas, of the County in the event of emergency situations or critical community alerts. Examples include: evacuation notices, bioterrorism alerts, boil water notices, chemical spills, or missing child reports.

We recognize that not every household has traditional landlines and that some homes now have cellular service as their primary means of communications. Therefore, you must register your cell phone number so in the event of an emergency or disaster public safety officials can notify you of important information.

Registering for the service can be done one of three ways. You may either visit www.clarkcountyohio.gov/ema or call 937 521 2179 to register your information. 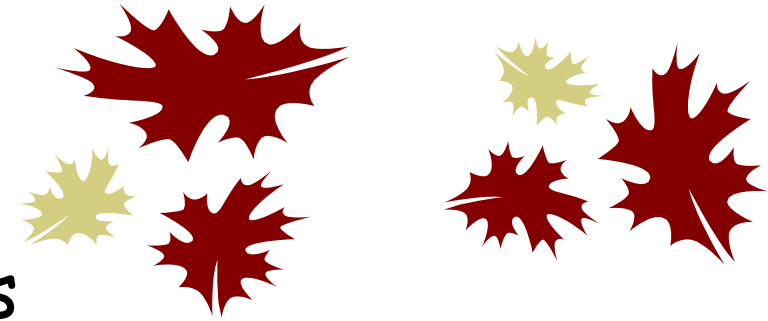
