

WARN Wide Area Rapid Notification

Clark County has instituted the WARN Wide Area Rapid Notification System-an Ultra high speed telephone communication service for emergency notifications.

The system allows us to telephone all, or only targeted areas, of the County in the event of emergency situations or critical community alerts. Examples include: evacuation notices, bioterrorism alerts, boil water notices, chemical spills, or missing child reports.

We recognize that not every household has traditional landlines and that some homes now have cellular service as their primary means of communications. Therefore, you must register your cell phone number so in the event of an emergency or disaster public safety officials can notify you of important information.

Registering for the service can be done one of two ways. You may either visit one of the websites listed, click on the WARN logo and submit your contact information directly into the secure WARN notification database; or you may call

937-521-2179 and leave a recorded message with your contact information including your complete mailing address and any cell phone numbers associated with the address that you would want notified.

Please only put woody items at the curbside. Make sure that all stems are no larger than 3 inches in diameter. We do not pick up grass clippings or other yard waste. The chipper will be going down each street and alley to pick up items laid at curbside. The dates of chipping are April 15 through April 19. The next chipping will be in the fall.

An offender can be cited into Mayors Court if they do not rectify the problem after a warning from the Police Department
